Science Academy

What does it mean to use phenomena and questioning to support student sense-making?

This three-day learning academy provides Science teachers with the opportunity to explore classroom practices that prepare students for success in postsecondary settings. The academy is designed as an immersive workshop where teachers will explore their beliefs about teaching and learning, and align those beliefs with daily practices that support an inquiry approach to science instruction.

Participants will consider:

(1) how engaging students in a common phenomenon and encouraging their connections to everyday phenomena capitalizes on student experience to support more equitable learning opportunities for all students.

(2) the problem of practice that students often experience science as a series of disconnected activities or activities driven by the teacher rather than grounded in their own questions, curiosities, and ideas about the world around them.
